Dartmouth Medical School is seeking individuals who:

- Are diagnosed with schizophrenia or schizoaffective disorder.
- Currently smoke marijuana or have smoked regularly in the last two years.

What we would ask you to do:

- Answer some questions about yourself and your history.
- Complete paper-and-pencil tests of memory and other brain activity.
- Undergo one magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) scan of the brain.

Basic Criteria for be in the study:

- Between 18 and 55 years of age
- Right-handed
- At least 10 years of education or G.E.D., and able to read English
- No history of neurological disorder (e.g., head trauma, seizure, stroke)
- Good physical health
- Normal or corrected hearing and eyesight
- No metal in your body

People who enroll in the study will receive:

- Scans and assessments that are part of the study are provided at no cost.
 - Feedback about the results will be provided in writing.
- Transportation to and from Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, NH is provided at no cost.
- A stipend.
